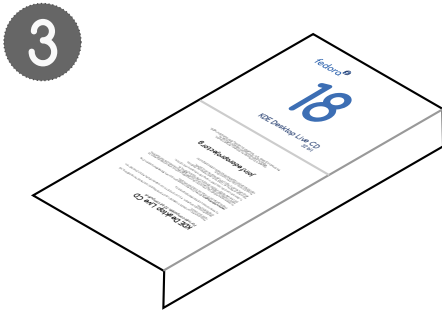




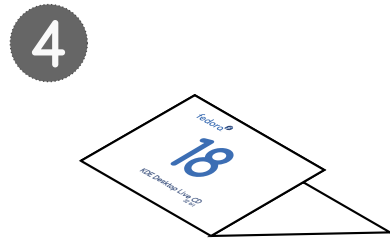
Print out the sleeve



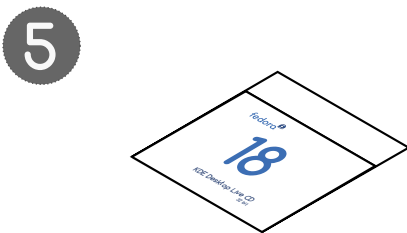
Fold the left hand flap underneath



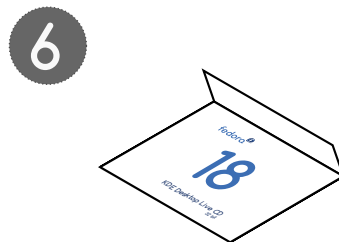
Fold the right hand flap underneath



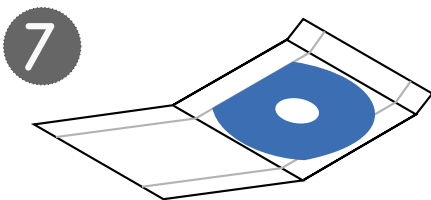
Fold the back cover underneath



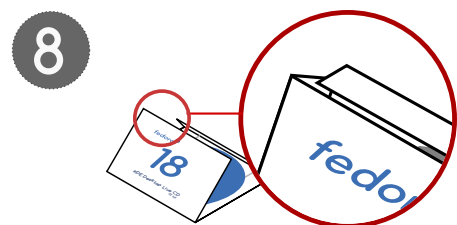
The cover should look like this.



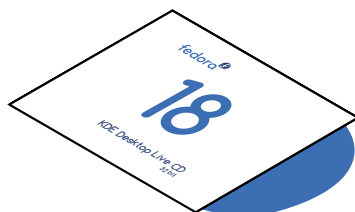
fold the top flap over the top of the front cover
